



Don't get me wrong. Those two items are very important, but if we can take our time and help the new Brothers attain the knowledge they are seeking, we believe they will be more apt to remain active. We have to give the Brothers, not only the new Brothers but our Brothers who have been members of this great Fraternity for years, a reason to come to Lodge.

When I became a Mason in 1971 the emphasis was on Ritual and doing Degree work. Most Lodges had a strong group of Past Masters who were the real power in the Lodge. If the Master did good ritual he was considered a good Master. There was no emphasis on Masonic Education. In fact, despite being a Mason for over 50 years many of the younger members have much more knowledge of Esoteric Masonry than I do. That is why we are concentrating so much on Masonic Education.

W.B. Tyler Beebe, our Junior Warden, has stepped up to be our Masonic Education Chairman. If there is a particular program you would be interested in seeing presented or if there is a program you would like to present yourself contact W.B. Tyler and get the program on the calendar.

Speaking of programs, if ritual is not your forte take a look at the committees we have. Maybe you can serve Brainard Lodge by either chairing a committee or being a committee member. Committees are important and the more Brothers we get involved the better it is for all of us.




