Brother Chad Leinbach SW (acting master) opened the floor for comments on our "rituals". The first input he received from the floor was on one of the words in the Fellowcraft degree. It is, of course, sourced to the Holy Bible. And, it has been adopted in secular speech as well. The word and concept played a significant role in a particular bible account and in this degree.

The next input from the floor concerned the **use of the lights** in the MM ritual. It seemed to this brother that at times the manipulation of the lights is, to say the least, haphazardly done and then, just as an afterthought. When in fact, that manipulation is, or can be, a major factor in establishing the flow of time in the drama of the degree. This, for the edification of the candidate as well as for newly made masons who might be in attendance and still learning.
