**Memorial Day** Gen. John Alexander Logan's (according to online research, Logan was a Master Mason from Illinois, having been raised in Mitchell Lodge No. 85 in Pinckneyville, Illinois) ordered his posts to decorate graves in 1868. His acts are as poignant today as they must have been hundreds of years ago: "with the choicest flowers of springtime, We should guard their graves with sacred vigilance. ... Let pleasant paths invite the coming and going of reverent visitors and fond mourners. Let no neglect, no ravages of time, testify to the present or to the coming generations that we have forgotten as a people, the cost of a free and undivided republic."


