Necrology



Sadly, in the past few months, four of our brothers have been called to the Grand Lodge on High.

Brother John P. Kennedy passed

away on Wednesday August 24, 2022. John was born in 1942. John's father-in-law (his first wife) was Elmer Gardiner, PM of Columbia Lodge in 1948. John's brother-in-law Leon Gardiner, PM of Columbia Lodge in 1965 recommended John to become a Mason. He was raised in Columbia #25 on June 5, 1968, with Bob Flint as Worshipful Master. John graduated from Cheney Tech in Manchester and joined the Navy where he served on a ship as part of the Cuba blockade in late October 1962. He took some ribbing from his shipmates during this tense time as he and the President (no relation) had the same name. He had been living in Mims, FL for some time.

Brother Anthony Gesnaldo passed away on Thursday June 1, 2023. Anthony was born in Hartford on March 6, 1947. Tony was raised in Daskam-Columbia #25 on November 6, 1996. He was a member of Pythagoras Chapter #17, Royal Arch Masons and the Valley of Hartford A.A.S.R.. He was a retired barber who was proud of his civic contributions, enjoyed time with his family, and indulging in a beautiful meal with a fine glass of wine and a cigar to follow.

Right Worshipful Brother Anthony F. Keegen passed away on Friday, August 18, 2023. He was born in June 1940. Tony was raised in Saint John's Lodge No. 4 of West Hartford on June 22, 1977. He served as Worshipful Master of Saint John's in 1982. Saint John's consolidated with Wyllys iin 1988. Tony served Wyllys-St. John's Lodge No. 4 as Trustee. Tony affiliated with Daskam Lodge No. 86 in the north end of Glastonbury. Daskam Lodge, through two consolidations became part of Columbia Lodge No. 25 in 2006. Tony served Columbia Lodge No. 25 as Trustee as well as ritual director for the Master Mason Degree for many years. He served as Worshipful Master in 2020. In 1993, RW Gerald F. Thompson asked Tony to serve as Associate Grand Marshall with him in District 6C. They served together in 1994 as well. In 2009, MWGM Arthur H. Carlstrom appointed Tony as District Deputy in District 6A. He was reappointed by MWGM Charles A. Buck, Jr. in 2010.

Tony was coronated a Sovereign Grand Inspector General, 33°, A.A.S.R. in 2003. He served as Commander-in-Chief of Nathan Hale Consistory in 2005-6. He served as Treasurer of the Valley of Hartford, A.A.S.R. for many years.
