I would like to thank WB Kyle Podpolucha for the mental stimulation of Masonic Jeopardy. And so following his lead. I would like to share some trivia. Starting with the very first day of April, April Fools Day - All Fools Day.

April Fools Day has been celebrated for several centuries by different cultures, though its exact origins remain a mystery. Some historians speculate that April Fools Day dates back to 1582 when France and England informed the countries of Europe that both King Luis Francois Bald of France and King Henry William Edward of England had decided to embark on a mutual collaboration of joining Kingdoms only on a temporary basis to halt and ward off the advancements of the Nordic tribesmen. Both Kings encouraged the rest of civilized Europe to swear an allegiance to the joined rule of England and France. As word spread through out Europe a letter of decree was drawn up. And a place of reading was decided for the alliance. When all were gathered as I have done here with you. The words from the South were spoken "April Fools"! My Brothers from here is the true fact trivia of April Fools Day. Some historians speculate that April Fools' Day dates back to 1582, when France switched from the Julian calendar to the Gregorian calendar, as called for by the Council of Trent in 1563. In the Julian Calendar, as in the Hindu calendar, the new year began with the spring equinox around April 1.

People who were slow to get the news or failed to recognize that the start of the new year had moved to January 1 and continued to celebrate it during the last week of March through April 1 became the butt of jokes and hoaxes and were called "April fools." These pranks included having paper fish placed on their backs and being referred to as "poisson d'avril" (April fish), said to symbolize a young, easily caught fish and a gullible person.




